יהוה Yahweh, our Heavenly Fathers only Name.
 אֲדֹנָי Hebrew: Adonai, means lord, master. Sarah called Abraham "lord" in Genesis 18:12

What About Scripture: Ephesians 2:15

Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances (**δόγμασιν**): for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; (KJV)

[[Liddell-Scott] **δόγμασιν**: that which seems to be an opinion Plat. 2. a public decree, ordinance, Xen., Dem.

Expanded Translation: Having abolished, when he died, the man-made traditions attached to the Torah that violated what the Father required as far as Jew and Gentile co-existing together...Making One New Man and in this, creating peace.
